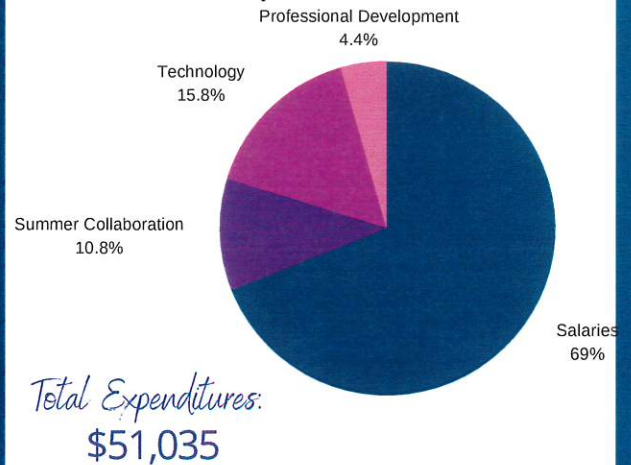

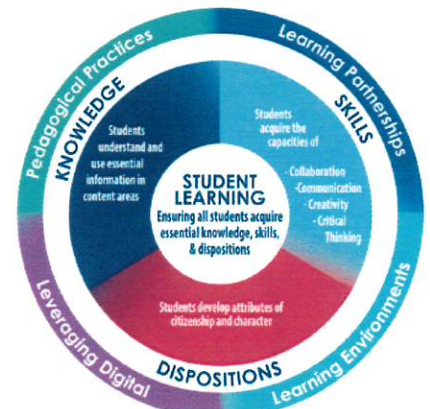

- General supplies were provided to support the implementation of deep learning school-wide

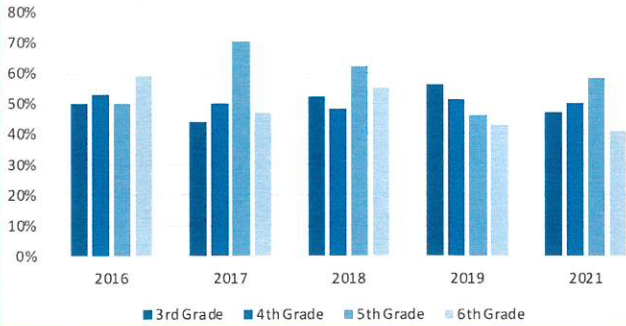


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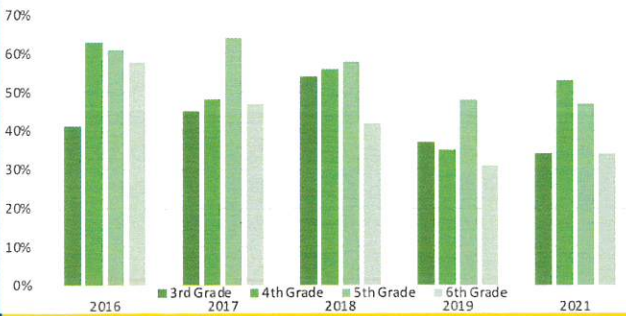
Assessment Data



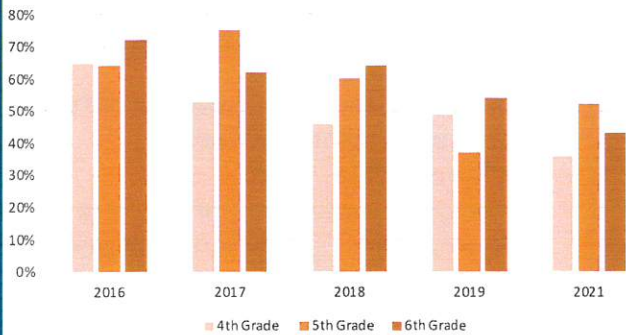
ELA Rise Scores
