Halloween Parade

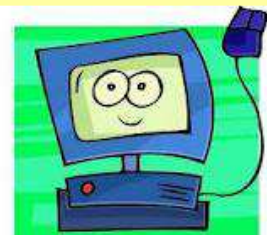
Parents, come see the goblins, and zombies, and fairies, (oh my!) as the students parade through the Cafeteria.
