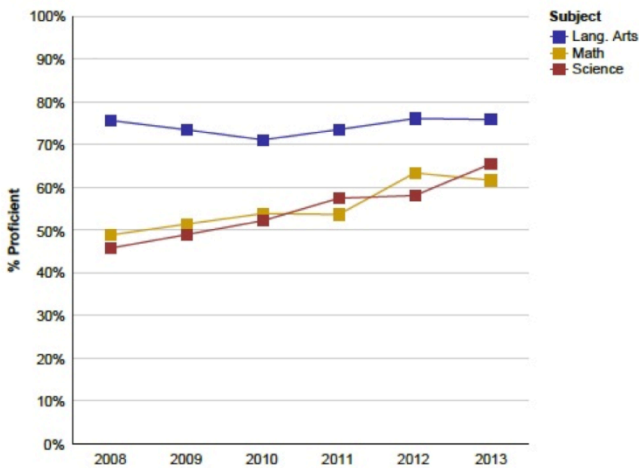

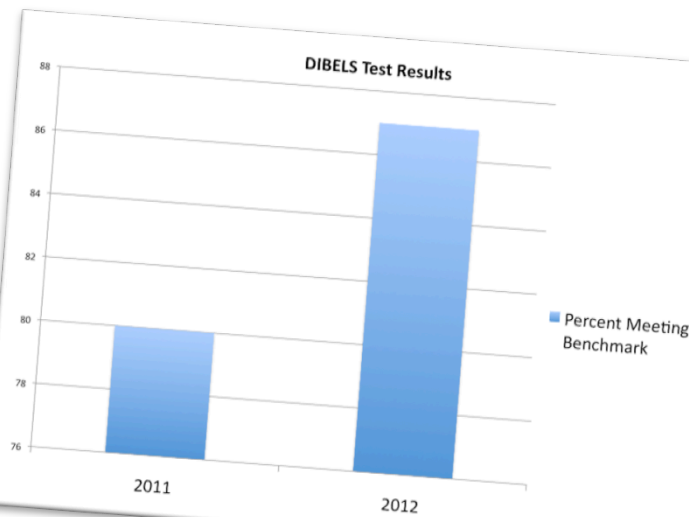
End of Year Test Results

Alpine Online’s end of year CRT results show a steady growth in proficiency. We are especially excited about the improvement in Science scores from 2012 to 2013.

The chart below shows the results of the DWA (Direct Writing Assessment), an online writing assessment administered to 5th and 8th graders each spring.



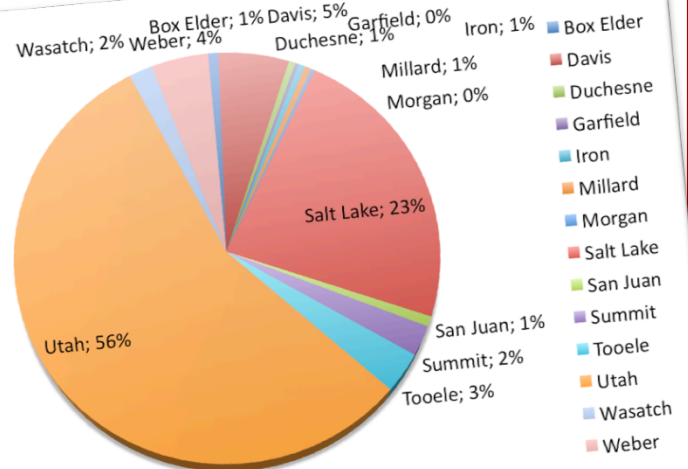
DIBELS Test Results

Where We Live

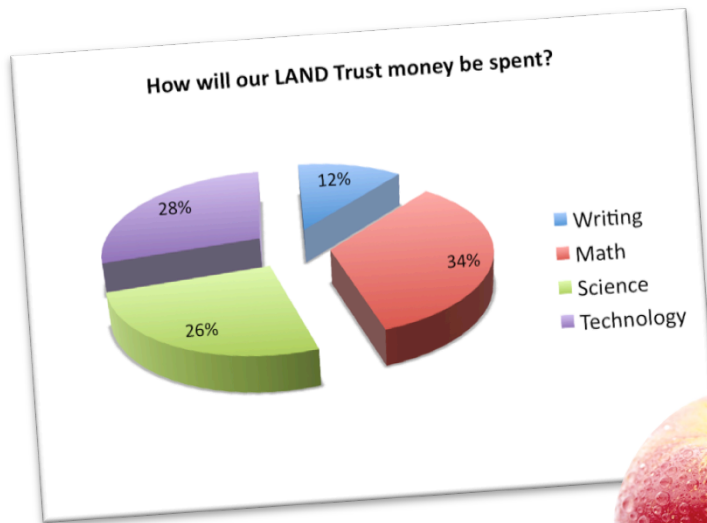
