1. Business:

- Introductions: Hillary Clark

2. Trust LAND Plan: Dan Heaps

- The Council reviewed the 2020-2021 Trust Land plan. Goal #1 in a reading progress goal. Goal #2 is a health goal focusing on occupational therapy.
- Reading Goal: Over the summer faculty discussed and created the prompt hierarchy used to measure the progress for this goal.
- Health Goal: This goal is driven by occupational therapy. Gary Robinson (Horizon OT) will be presenting to all of the faculty at the next professional development day. He will be training teachers strategies for enhancing the sensory world in the classroom. This is especially import because the sensory room is closed this year.
