This procedure is necessary based on changes in State Statute that require scores to be provided to parents within 2 weeks of testing concluding

We need your help with the following:

- Send a copy of the ISRs home with each student. A recommendation would be to have teachers
 print it and send it home with the student. The school should keep the digital file handy. ISRs are
 already available for students who have completed testing. Testing Coordinators, see the RISE
 reporting system guide p. 154-168 on how to print these and please help teachers as needed.
