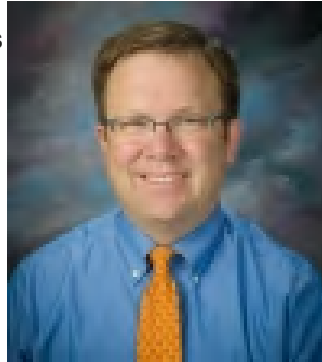

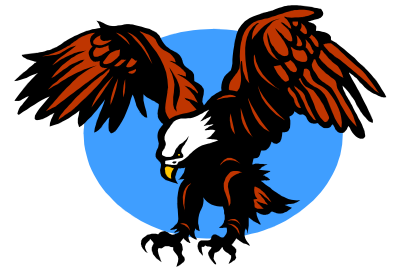
Yearbook Cover Contest!

Mile Club

Thanks to all those students and parents who have signed up this year for the mile club. We now are approximately 150 members strong. Parents please talk to your kids about their goal and help motivate them to reach it. Some younger runners and those runners who got a later start might want to think about setting a **marathon goal of 26.2 miles**. They could earn a marathon shirt for this! We have 105 days (27 weeks) left in the school year so if your child wants to run:

26.2 miles = 2 days/week (runs .5 mile a day = 3 laps)

50 miles = 2 days/week (runs 1 mile a day = 6 laps)

75 miles = 3 days/week (runs 1 mile a day = 6 laps)

100 miles = 4 days/week (runs 1 mile a day = 6 laps)

How awesome would it be if our students Ran (collectively) 10,000 miles? We can do it!

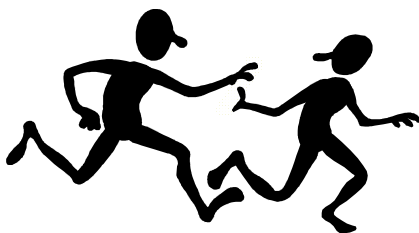

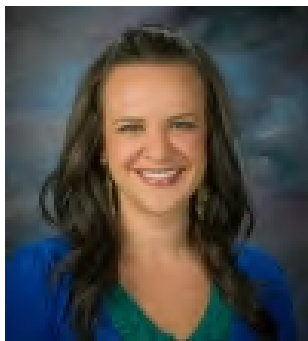
I have 1 dog, 2 cats, and 4 chickens. I love watching movies & TV, reading books, riding my bike, walking my dog, visiting National Parks,
