Take Home Reading

Thanks you parents for your continued support each year of the Take Home Reading program. This program is so valuable for our students here at Deerfield. Please remember that consistent reading (3–5 books exchanged each week) is the best way to keep your student engaged with their reading and it also helps them to progress with their reading levels. If students are on higher levels or reading chapter books, they are allowed to keep the books for 3 weeks. No other books should be kept out longer than this. It has been my experience that if books are out more than 30 days at a time, the books become lost and the student does not progress with their reading levels.


